#### History of the Organisation:

The first Hostel for boys was started in 1991. At present the Trust runs Ashram Shala at Agiyol, Computer Education Center at Agiyol. The trust provides not only residential accommodation but also free lodging to children, who come from villages to get education at Agiyol.

In the year 2014-15 organisation is awarded by MAHATMA GANDHI AWARD for its remarkable activities in the field of social development.

In the year 2016-17 we have constructed Dining Hall at Ashram Shala Agiyol with the kind help of ONGC-New Delhi under CSR Scheme.




# Main objectives of organization-


The specific aim of the trust is to provide education / literacy to poor and needy students of the tribal area.

Another main objectives of the organisation are;

- To undertake, conduct and help accordingly all educational activities "Balvadi" to Higher Education like Anganvadis, Balmandirs, Ghodiyaghars, Pri-primary secondary and Higher Secondary schools adults education, Instruction, Technical, Education also undertake an all type of efforts to be help full the necessary classes useful for the employment training and instruction.
- To start and develop the various study center and hostels for boys & girls education.
- ◆ To start creative activities to complete development 7 general education.
- To work for social & cultural development.
- To start & conduct an activities relating to development for Tribal peoples, Baxipanch, S.C., and O.B.C. locality.
- ◆ To start, conduct and accordingly help the "Balvadies", Cultural centers, Training centers, Art centers, Publisher institutions, Library and also undertake the administration of such running activities.
- Health related awareness generation
- Environmental Awareness Campaign







Our organisation is running one Ashram Shala and one Boys Hostel for the educational development of the poor and tribal children of the Targeted Areas. With the prime motive to develop educational activities for the tribal poor students we providing the necessary things like Stationary (i.e. books, note books, pen, pencils, Compass Box, Color Box, Drawing Book, charts, maps etc.) School Bags, School Uniforms, shoes, Socks and all type of study material to develop the educational activities and qualities among students. We have regularly arrange the programs of Medical check-up for the students twice in a year with necessary treatment and medicines. To develop their social and cultural activities, it is also planned that Cultural program and Educational tours will be executed time to time. It is regret to stated that due to lack of resources in above said tribal region peoples are living in small huts in forest of Arravalli region and they are not able to take benefit from various educational program of government. Being the remote area is the main reason for lack of resources / facilities and for the same our trust take the initiatives to develop the area with the development of education. As a Goal we plan that trust will provide the facilities to more than 400 students in a year and, to achieve the same we are committed to do all better efforts to provide more advanced and necessary facilities compared to student who belong to cities and coming from well settled family background, we decide to purchase kitchen Equipment's and related items and other educational things like Magazines on History, Science and General Knowledge related Books, Black Board, Audio & Visual equipment's etc.

## JIVAN JYOT ASHRAM SHALA, AGIYOL

Sabarkantha is one of the most backward district of Gujarat. It has a high density (as high as 55%) of trible & scheduled caste population. To educate these backward communities an Ashram Shala was started with the help of the Government. Children from std. 1 to 8 are being educated in this school.










# GYAN VINAY KUMAR CHHATRALAYA (HOSTEL)

For the over educational development of the poor and tribal children we also run a Hostel. The basic idea to commence this Hostel was to ensure that students who live in remote village and who are unable to travel daily to their home after their school and as a result were unable to get education.

The Hostel provides facilities to the students of remote areas to come and live here during their studies. Efforts are made to give them education culture and guidance. Free lodging and boarding is provided to them. The Hostel was established in 1991. During the first year 20 students were admitted. The trust tried its best to provide all facilities to the students. students from std.5th to 12th are admitted in this hostel. At present 81 students are availing the benefits from this institution. It is proposed to construct a new Hostel building in near future.



During the year 2017-18 organization work in field for healthy and pure environment. Organisation conducted awareness generation program at school level as well as at rural and interior areas of the sabarkantha district. We have conducted following activities on environment issue:
